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**TEENS (*Teen Electronic Event Notification Service*) PROGRAM**

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**The TEENS Program is a voluntary FREE service provided by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles that informs the parent or guardian of an underage teenage driver when a conviction, revocation, suspension or accident is posted to the younger driver's license record.**

**Preconditions for Enrollment**

The following conditions must be met to enroll in the program:

- The younger driver is under the age of 18
- The parent/guardian has given their consent for their child to get a NYS permit or license
- The parent/guardian has a NYS license or non-driver ID

**How to Enroll**

To enroll in this program, the parent/guardian must obtain form **MV-TEENS** *Teen Electronic Event Notification Service Enrollment and Consent*. This form can be obtained two ways:

- Downloaded from DMV's website [www.nysdmv.com](http://www.nysdmv.com)
- Ask for form MV-TEENS at a NYS DMV issuing office.

The parent/guardian must fill out the form *completely*. The following information is required to fill out the form:

- Parent/guardian's name
- Parent/guardian's Client ID (License ID #)
- Young Driver's name
- Young Driver's Client ID (License ID #)
- Young Driver's birth date
- Parent/guardian relationship to the young driver
- Parent/guardian's signature
